

NOTICE OF RACE

Sail Sand Point - Seattle, WA
October 20-21 2012

1. HOST

The event will be hosted by Sail Sand Point and the University of Washington Sailing Team.

2. DATES

Saturday the 20th through Sunday the 21st of October 2012

3. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the ICSA/ISSA Procedural Rules (Fall 2009 – Spring 2012), the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of sailing, the prescriptions of US sailing, the Sailing Instructions and Notice of Race.

4. FORMAT AND ELIGIBILITY

All NWISA and NWICSA sailors are eligible to compete. This is an “open” event for high school sailors. High School and Collegiate Sailors will compete in the same fleet in an A/B division fleet racing format. It is our hope that NWISA sailors will have the opportunity to sail and speak with NWICSA teams about their programs and college sailing in the NW in general. College sailors plan to give a 5 minute presentation about your team during the forum.

Entry fee for High School sailors is \$20/sailor: entry will include housing Saturday night, Saturday and Sunday lunches and Sunday breakfast. There is no entry fee for college sailors. College sailors and parents can purchase lunch tickets for \$5 while supplies last.

5. BOATS

This regatta will be sailed in FJs. Some charters may be available on a limited basis. SSP charters are being split between HS and College teams so we will have VERY limited charters available. If you are able to bring FJ's, you are strongly encouraged to do so.
