

Sand Point Team Race
Seattle, WA
March 31 - April 1, 2012

Eight High School Sailing Teams enjoyed a weekend of Team Racing at Sail Sand Point in Seattle. Spectating was made easy with an "N" course set right off the Sand Point pier. After a double round-robin qualifying series with all eight teams, the fleet was split into a top four championship division and consolation division where another single round robin was completed. In total, 68 races were completed to decide the champion. Mother Nature threw a little bit of everything at us during the two-day event.

Saturday started with steady North winds (and steady rain) that held for the first 3 races of the regatta, but faded during race 4 which was eventually abandoned. After about an hour on-shore postponement the forecast Southerly filled in and the race committee was able to sail 12 more races in a 2-4 knot South breeze before the wind again disappeared. After another half-hour wait ashore the clouds parted and with the sun came a consistent 3-5 knot Southerly that was enough to complete the rest of the first round robin of 28 races.

Sunday had breeze all day. Racing started promptly at 10:00 in a 6-10 knot Southerly with numerous puffs in the mid and high teens. Another qualifying round robin was completed before the fleet was separated into championship division and consolation division. The final 12 races were sailed in just under an hour and a half, and racing concluded at 2:50 under sunny skies and solid south breeze.

The event would not have been possible without the large number of volunteers. Thanks to PRO Brendan Fahey and his team; Nino Johnson, Jon Kelch, Glen Stellmacher, Taylor Smith, and Taylor Hubbard, who helped on the finish boat and with markset to keep the "N" square in, at times, wet and challenging conditions. Thank you to Andi Pistay and her team of volunteers who kept the sailors well fed with a BBQ Saturday and Chili feed Sunday. Thanks to Morgan Collins and Kim Iorio of Sail Sand Point for all their efforts leading up to the event and helping with breakdowns along the way. And thanks to Glen Stellmacher, Kyle Eaton and Jon Kelch for hearing two protests: one resulting in a DSQ. A giant thank you to Friday Harbor and Orcas Island High School's for bringing 3 V15's each to give us a third fleet in addition to Sand Point's 12 FJ's.
